

City of Cleveland Regular Meeting Minutes – February 3, 2020

The regular meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Mayor Don McCabe, Councilmembers present were Nancy Gens, Justin Schabert, Fred Danner and Glenn Beer.

No amendments to the agenda

A Motion was made by Schabert and seconded by Danner to approve the January 6th, 2020 Minutes and the current bills. Voting yes – all

Police Report – Chief Tiegs was not present but city clerk stated that Tiegs will be mailing letters to any property owners that fail to remove snow on their sidewalks after a snow fall per our city ordinance.

Public Works Report – Jared Holland was not present, approved.

Liquor Report – Approved

Dale Wills approached the city clerk prior to the meeting to inquire if the city would be interested in adding 10 more sewer connections to the West Jefferson Sewer Project. City clerk advised the council that he spoke with Jason Femrite city engineer with Bolton and Menk. Jason advised that the city should consider a more conservative approach and wait until flow numbers from the lake area come in. This was explained to the council in which it was agreed that the city would keep the West Jefferson Sewer Project at 140 connections. The city would wait and analysis the flow data in a few years to see if additional connections are advisable.

A Motion was made by Gens and seconded by Schabert to set the Board of Appeal and Equalization Hearing for April 6, 2020 and 5:30 p.m. Voting yes – all

Mayor McCabe advised the council that a meeting took place on January 31st, 2020 between the city staff and the Le Sueur County Highway Dept. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the road surface conditions of County State Aid Highways (CSAH) 49 (2nd Street) and 46 (Broadway Street) with-in the city limits. Dave Tiegs Le Sueur County Highway Engineer, in that meeting advised that the county is aware of the deteriorating road surfaces and would likely access the roadways in question in the spring of 2020. Dave indicated that the county would like to do a temporary patch/fix and depending on funding sources do the appropriate permanent fix in approximately two years.

A Motion was made by Schabert and seconded by Beer to amend Resolution #01-2020 to add Kate Anderson to the Planning and Zoning Commission. Voting yes – all

A Motion was made by Schabert and seconded by Danner to approve Resolution #05-2020 calling for Election Judges for The Presidential Primary on March 3, 2020. Voting yes – all

A Motion was made by Danner and seconded by Beer to approve Resolution #06-2020, accepting a donation from the Fire Relief to the Police Department for a radar unit. Voting yes – all

Councilmember Gens updated the council on the 2020 Cherry Creek Days event. Gens said there will be a bingo fundraiser at the American Legion in Cleveland on March 7, 2020 and May 9, 2020. The Cherry Creek Day Committee is looking for volunteers to help pass out bingo cards on those nights.

A Motion was made by Danner and seconded by Schabert to Adjourn at 6:11 p.m. Voting yes – all
